1. King Charles I gave the Puritans a charter to settle in North America.
2. In 1675 Metacomet led a revolt against the English.
3. King George supported the plan of the colony of Georgia because it would protect the Carolinas from the Spanish and the French.
4. The Middle Colonies was known as the 'breadbasket' of the colonies.
5. In the Puritan community all free male colonists signed an agreement called a covenant.
6. Georgia was a place for English debtors to live.
7. Maryland was a colony where Catholics could practice their religion.
8. New York was a Dutch colony taken over by the English.
9. Rhode Island was the first colony to allow freedom of religion.
10. Pennsylvania was a colony founded by the Quakers.
11. The leader of the Puritans was John Winthrop.
12. The Puritans founded the Massachusetts Bay Company.
13. The Puritans first settlement was Boston.
14. Roger Williams founded Providence.
